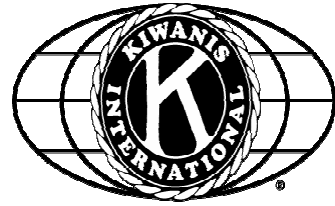

We intend to include Toft's Dairy, Mulberry Creek, Firelands Campus, the Route 250 area, and we need more bright ideas including businesses and local scenes that we come up with.
